Beginning June 6th, 2017, passports (or passport cards) will be required to enter federal establishments, including military bases. In January 2018, passports will be required to fly within and outside of Alaska. It is unknown at this point when the State of Alaska will provide compliant licenses.

Please read the requirements in the link above carefully, as you may have to apply in person even if you've had a passport before.
